Message from Outgoing President

By means of this message, as a past-CIGR President, I thank all CIGR members and the Presidium for the activities we were able to carry out during my term of service to further our profession. Some relevant past and future activities are listed below.

To address the rapid developments in Ai and Data Science CIGR sponsored a working group and the organization of NVIDIA artificial intelligence workshop. NVIDIA provided in-kind a two-day workshop on AI that was attended by over 45 people in February 2022.

CIGR supported ASABE's Global initiative to provide a framework to develop and sustain innovation through the world and ASABE's Circular Bioeconomy which resulted in the creation a related workgroup.

During the 77th International Conference "LAND.TECHNIK - AgEng 2019", the German Agricultural Society, or DLG and CIGR entered into a collaboration agreement for the development of projects on common interests aligned with the mission of both organizations.

CIGR supported the online conference held in Canada in May 2021 organized by the Canadia Society for Bioengineering, fully online due to the pandemic. This successful conference was the first of its kind in which CIGR was involved and required a major effort for the organizers to make a fully online event. This paved the way to have blended participation with people in presence and online, like in the CIGR World Congress in Kyoto in December 2022 that convened delegates from all over the world. This provided the opportunity for

many participants to visit Japan and enjoy culture, food and cultural heritage.

Another huge success was the organization of the conference in Jeju Island, Republic of Korea, in May 2024. The venue, the beauty of the island, the food and the kindness of organizers and people there were all part of a unique experience.

The CIGR journal continues to operate and increase its reach. It is a journal that provides professionals unable to pay page charges costs to publish their work at no cost. The CIGR Journal implements a rigorous peer review process.

Through a regularly published newsletter CIGR provides updates on activities, membership, conferences, and regional societies. The newsletter is published four times per year. The newsletter is now sent to over 18,000 members of all our regional and national societies as well as corporate members around the world. Any member is welcome to submit contributions of interest to CIGR stakeholders.

The CIGR website was redesigned and now contains updated information on members, conferences and all CIGR activities and governing bodies. You are welcome to send events, news, and other items you feel are of interest to the CIGR members and update your information there. We need your engagement to constantly update the members' information.

Engineering also needs young professionals. For this reason, we will continuously push the establishment of a young CIGR society, to involve students that later will become professional in the sector. CIGR engaged with ALEIA, the Latin American student engineering association. By integrating student members, CIGR aims to engage a young generation of professionals and encourage their participation in our society.

Now my term is complete, and I have stepped down from the position as a member of the Presidium.

Was a privilege and an honor to work with such qualified people for the past six years.

Starting July I become incoming president of EurAgEng, so I will try to strengthen the links between CIGR and EurAgEng during my mandate there. I will continue to contribute closely to the CIGR activities in the future. Especially as I will be serving as co-chair of the 2026 CIGR World Congress jointly held with the EurAgEng Conference. I hope to see many of you at this event to be held in Torino, Italy, and organized in cooperation with Prof. Patrizia Busato, at the Polytechnic of Turin in 2026.

I welcome the new CIGR President, my colleague and friend Claus Soerensen, From University of Aarhus, Denmark, who deserves respect from all of us for his scientific competence and his role, first in CIGR technical section V and later as incoming president of CIGR.

Second Call: CIGR Incoming President Nominations

The Secretary General's Office is accepting nominations for CIGR Incoming President per Article 7 of the CIGR statutes. Nominations can be made only by representatives of member organizations. Nominations must be submitted by November 25th, 2024. Term of service is for six

years starting in 2025: Two years as Incoming President, two years as President and two years as Past President. The nomination package must include: 1. A letter from the nominating member organization representative that includes contact information of the nominator, the nominee and the

three supporting individuals. 2. A 500-word summary of the nominee's activities demonstrating leadership within the profession and a track record of participation in CIGR activities. 3. The CV or Resume of the nominee. 4. Three letters from individuals supporting the nomination. Only complete nomination packages will be accepted and must be submitted in a single package. Incomplete nomination packages will not be considered, and the
